- 1. Provide insight on the impact of COVID-19 in their community.
- 2. **Explore** in greater detail a specific local social issue that has faced significant pressure due to the crisis.
- 3. **Identify** a local OSCR-registered charity doing valuable work to address this issue and how the grant could potentially support their activities during the current crisis.
- 4. Present the above with style, creativity and conviction.
