Congratulations to a number of our current S6 students who signed up to take part in an initiative piloted by The University of Edinburgh and have progressed to Phase 3. This has been set up to tackle educational inequality; taking the University to the school and underlining that everyone is welcome and valued,

In March 2020 we had 8 students who applied to participate in a pilot programme – Your Ed+ - an initiative set up by University of Edinburgh to mentor S5 students to widen their horizons and opportunities for applying to Higher Education.

Students had to submit an application with a personal statement in S4 and during lockdown the feedback from Your Ed+ was very positive and the calibre of our pupils was outstanding.

PHASE 1 – STUDY SKILLS

Students completed Phase 1 in February 2021 - this consisted of attending 8 twilight sessions focussing on Study Skills. This message was sent out to pupils by Matt Lucas UoE Widening Participation Officer (Schools Partnership).
