S4 Arrangements

Please use this in conjunction with the individual SQA timetable distributed tomorrow in tutor time.

Learners with 5 or more National Qualification exams:	Entitled to full study leave from 26/4/22 to 01/06/22
Learners with 4 or less National Qualification exams:	Entitled to three days immediately before and then the day of the exam – four in total for each exam.
Learners who are not on exam leave will attend their timetable as normal; this will provide opportunity to complete any National 3 and National 4 qualifications and build further life skills.	

S5/6 Arrangements

All S5 and S6 learners:	Entitled to full study leave from 26/4/22 to 01/06/22
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For all S4/5/6 learners:

During exam leave, with prior agreement of the class teacher, learners are welcome to attend their timetabled lessons (in full school uniform) for support and preparation of their exams.

Learners must sign in and out of school at the main reception.

Easter Revision Support. Students [can sign up](#) from now until 6th April for the Easter revision sessions. They will need to log into Glow first. Glow passwords have previously been given to pupils. Please note the following information for logging into Glow:

- Logging into office365 and Glow at the same time on the same browser is not possible without issues.
- If a student is logged into office365 (e.g. to access emails) they must use a different browser, or the browser's incognito mode, to log into Glow. Then they can access the sign up links.

West OS
